

Any surplus from this show will go towards purchase of a memorial bench for the stable yard in memory of Roger Parkes who died in April after a short illness.

Competition arena is 60m x 20m with an all-weather rubber-on-sand surface, and there is also a 25m x 20m arena available for warm-up.

Please remember that the venue is a livery yard and respect the fact that owners of resident horses may still need access if not competing. Children are welcome but expected to be kept under adult supervision at all times.

If entering any class Hors Concours competitor number should be either removed or reversed to display blank side.

Freestyle to Music

Class 11 is a class to introduce Freestyle and will be judged on quality of gaits and movements and overall impression of harmony & fluidity.

The format will be very simple – you can:

- Make up your own test of no more than 4 mins duration.
- May be Walk/Jog only or include Lope
- The salute (which may be just a bow of the head) is the signal for your music to begin.

Bring a CD of your choice for “background” music – no need to change music for different gaits/paces, but if the beat suits so much the better !

Conditions

- 1) All classes will be judged using WES Rules as a guide.
- 2) Correct attire and footwear must be worn and all riders when mounted (whether or not competing) must wear appropriate headgear – **NO BASEBALL CAPS**. Juniors and beginners **MUST** wear hard hats marked BS/EN 1384, PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SE1 with a strap properly adjusted and fastened. Seniors in Novice or Open classes have the option to wear a Stetson but they do so entirely at their own risk and must present a disclaimer form before the show.
- 3) The Judge reserves the right to ask any competitor to withdraw if considered to be not in control of their horse or causing a problem to others, and may stop the class at any point if necessary.
- 4) Classes may be divided, combined or cancelled at the Organisers' discretion depending on entries.
- 5) No refund of entry fees unless a valid Medical or Veterinary certificate is received before the show day with an SAE for return, or presented to the Secretary on the show day before the start of the class.
- 6) Reasonable precautions have been taken to ensure the safety of everyone present, but neither Little Ladbroke Equestrian nor the organisers can be held responsible for any accident, injury, illness, damage or loss to horses, riders, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever or howsoever caused.

For health & safety measures to be effective, EVERYONE PRESENT shares the responsibility of avoiding situations which could result in an accident occurring, and MUST obey instructions of organisers without question or argument.

DIRECTIONS to LITTLE LADBROOK EQUESTRIAN (B94 5HL)

From **M42 Junc 3** take the **A435 South** towards Alcester and after about ½ mile exit on first slip-road for Portway which leads to the first bridge over the dual carriageway. At the junction at top of the slip road **turn left** into **Penn Lane** and the hidden entrance to **Ladbrook is ½ mile on the left**, just after you see a **row of logs** on the left verge. If you come to *Rushbrook Lane* on your right you have gone just past, so turn round and look for a gate 100m on right with a DOG FREE sign and a hedge of tall Leylandii along the drive just past Little Ladbrook Farm.

This is a working Livery Yard so please respect their rules and clear up any mess left by your horse and use the bins for your own litter. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Thank you.
